2. Recent Healthy Ulster County Developments

- Vin Martello Introduced the newly revised Healthy Ulster County Network website. Linked here: <http://healthyulstercounty.net/>
 - This site is designed to showcase all the prevention resources in Ulster County.
- Everyone is encouraged to post health related events using the *Event->List Your Event* tab.
 - The site also features a healthy *Lifestyle Business Directory*. Become a part of it by using the *List Your Product/Service/Program* tab to get listed.
- Reducing Youth Exposure to Tobacco Marketing Law passed the vote.
- Ulster County has a new Disposable Polystyrene Law (DPL)
 - Members asked: Why are hospitals, prisons, etc. exempt from law?
 - Can an alternative list be posted on a website?
- DEP to put \$2.5 million for development of a public rail trail along the Ashokan Reservoir.
 - Rail Road Contract expires next May
- Meals on Wheels being provided by Gateway Communities. The new program will include hot meal deliveries to eligible seniors, and enhanced at home support and advocacy for the County's most vulnerable seniors.

- Stages of Partnership- How do we get to collaboration?
 - 1) Networking, 2)Cooperation, 3)Coordination, 4)Collaboration

- Policy Change- meaning strategies may involve a law, ordinance, resolution, mandate, or rule.
- Systems Change- meaning strategies are changes that impact all elements of an organization, institution or system.
- Environmental Change-meaning strategies involve physical or material changes to the economic, social, or physical environment.
- Spectrum of Prevention: 1) Strengthening individual skills and knowledge; 2) Promoting community education; 3) Educating Providers; 4) Fostering coalitions and networks; 5) Changing organizational practices; 6) Influencing policy and legislation
- Moving Upstream Story
 - About pulling people out of the river from drowning, but have to look upstream to solve the over-arching problem of why they are falling in to begin with.
