Project Resilience- Goals



- Feed those in need (sheltering in place, economically impacted of COVID19)
- Support local restaurants in the abrupt shutdown
- FUNDING- \$2M in funding secured within in hours
- Simple web enrollment for people needing meals or restaurants to participate

Project Resilience- Phase 1 and Phase 2



- Announced on Tuesday March 17th
- Phase 1, ending Saturday May 16th 60 plus days
- Phase 2, Groceries, limited prepared meal deliveries

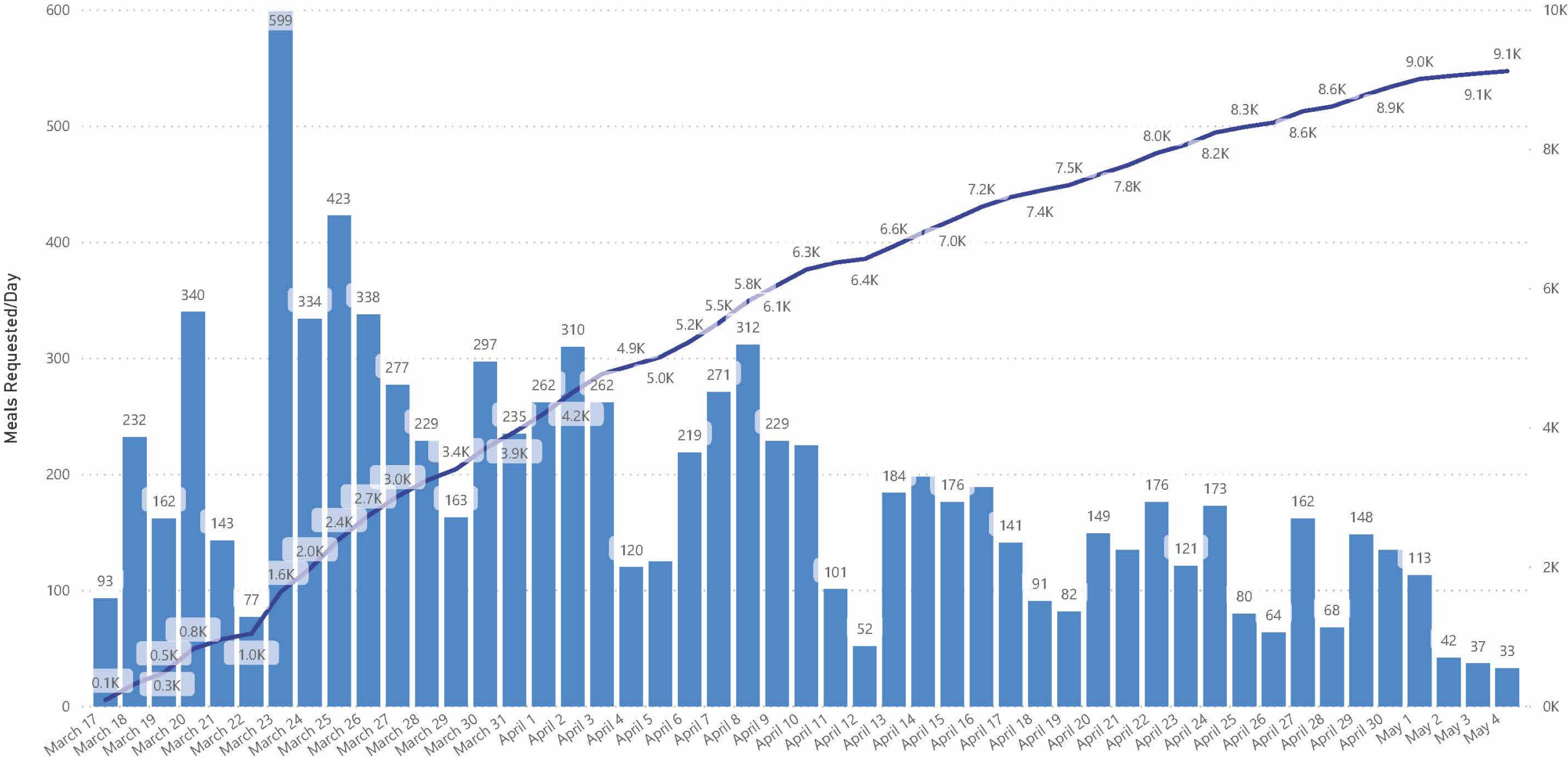
COVID-19: PROJECT RESILIENCE UPDATE

- **3,400** individuals/households have requested assistance through Project Resilience
- **104,900** meals delivered
- **42,975** meals provided by groceries
- **16** local teams established to distribute meals
- **160** restaurants have signed up

Project Resilience- Local Distribution Teams

- Recipients in 23 of the 24 Municipalities in UC.
- Between 16 to 20 teams, locally organized and coordinated, delivering to those meal recipients.



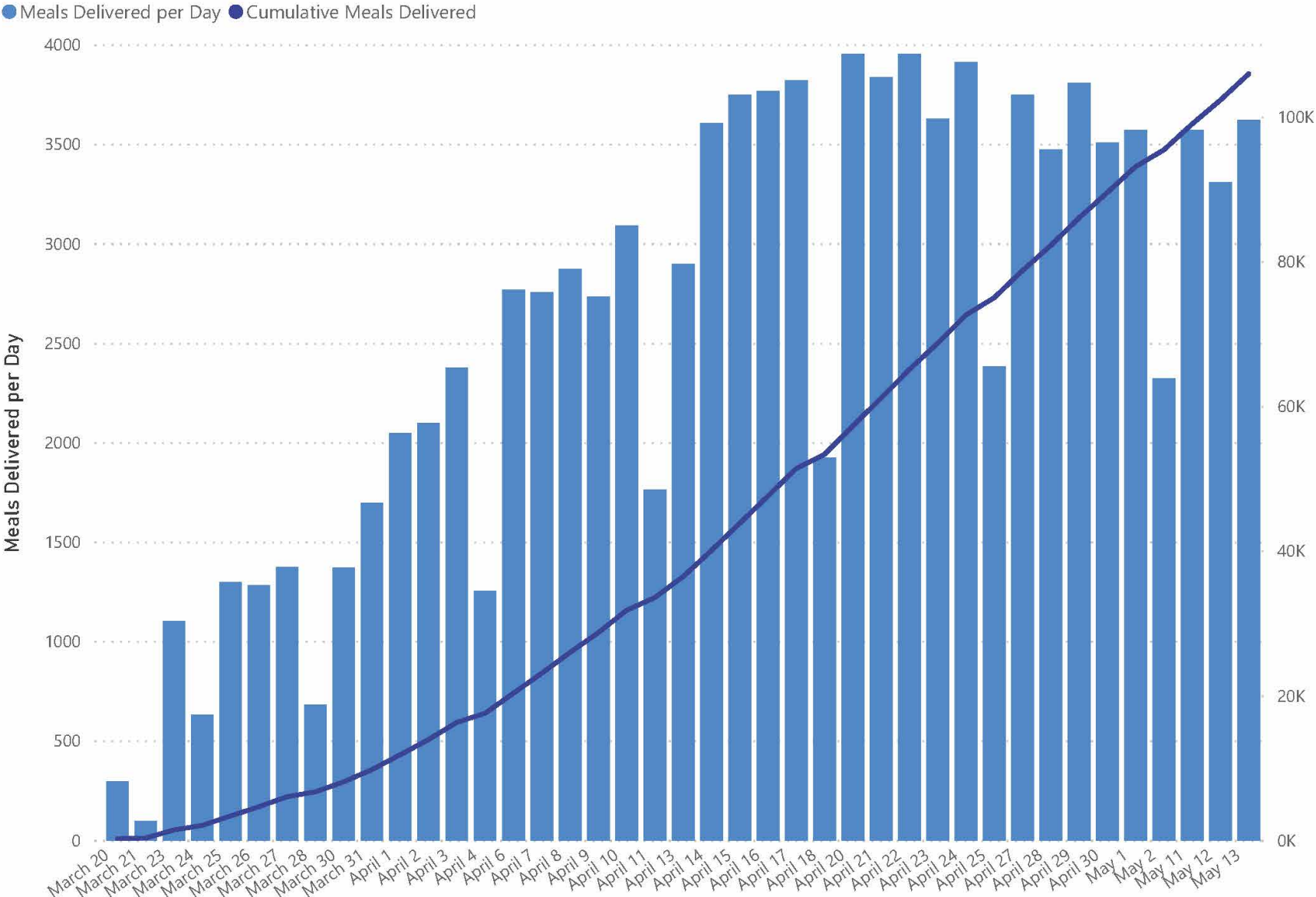

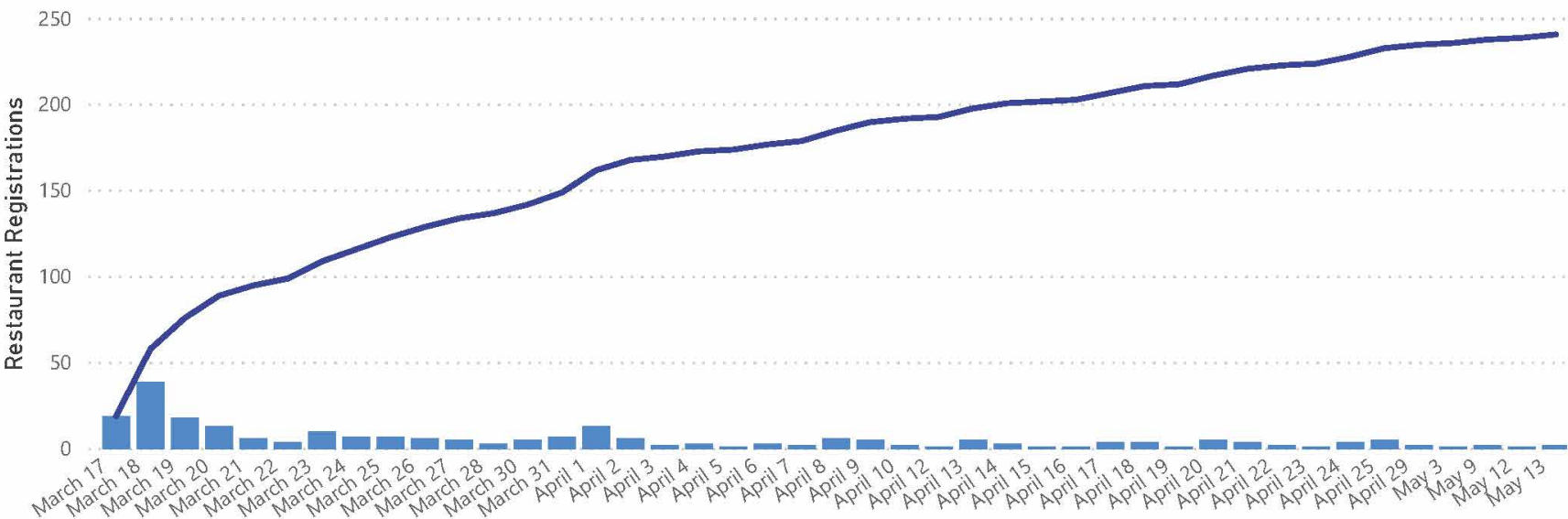

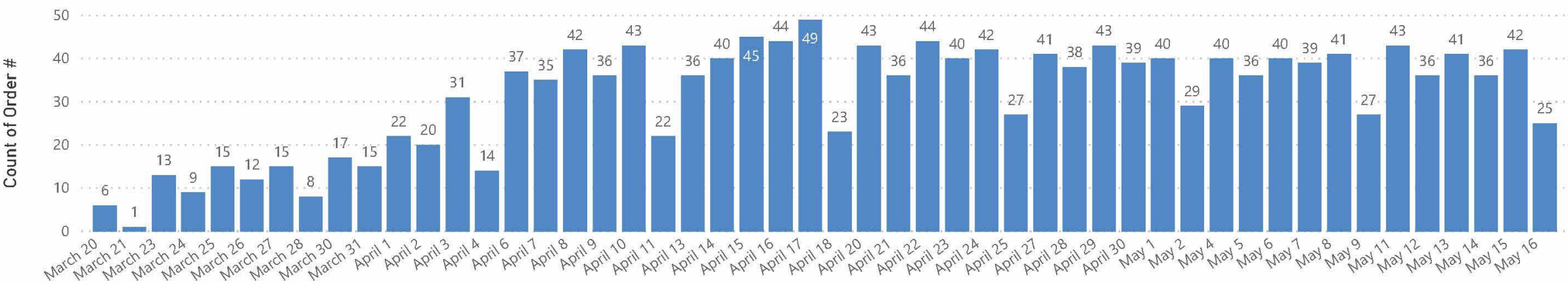

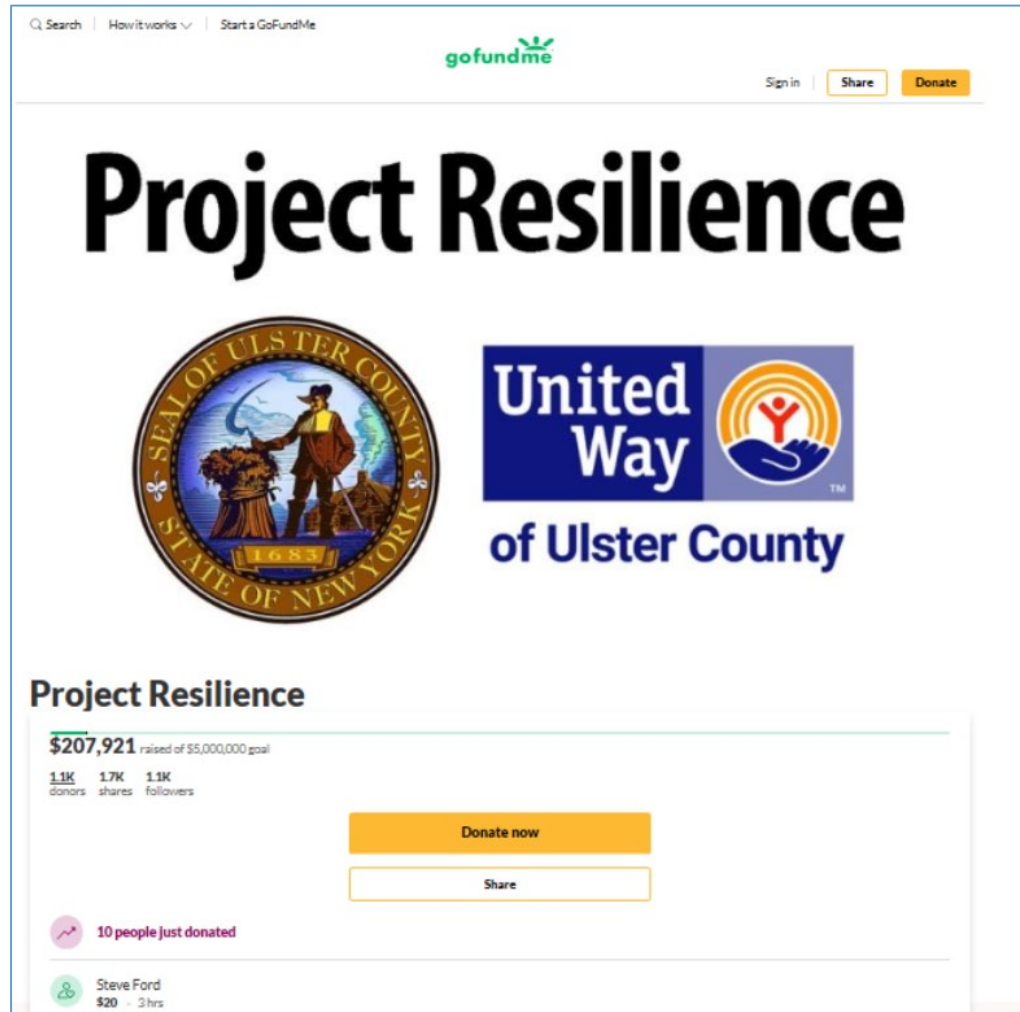
