Brief History

- Word 'hospice' linguistic root same as "hospitality"
- •1950s: Dame Dr. Cecily Saunders advocates for dying patients. Founder first St. Christopher's Hospice in London
- •1960s: Dr Elisabeth Kubler-Ross advocates for the dying in the US. Writes "On Death And Dying"
- •1974: Florence Wald, RN, two pediatricians and a chaplain, founded Connecticut Hospice in Branford, Connecticut
- •1986: The Medicare Hospice Benefit is made permanent by Congress
- Hudson Valley Hospice local non-profit healthcare agency providing care and support to Individuals of all ages who are faced with a life-limiting illness, and their loved ones. Serving Dutchess and Ulster Counties for 35 years



All hospice is palliative care, but all palliative care is NOT hospice...

Palliative Care

- Palliative care for symptom management of serious /chronic illness
- Quality of Life and Comfort
- Interdisciplinary Team
- Continue curative treatment
- Any point in disease trajectory
- Fee-for-service specialist, or philanthropic funding

Hospice Care

- Palliative care for advanced stage/end of life care management
- Quality of Life and Comfort
- Interdisciplinary Team
- Stop curative treatment
- Prognosis limited to six months or less
- Medicare and Medicaid pay 100%, private insurance with co-pay/ deductible



Who do we serve?

ALL Ages

 Any life-limiting illness or condition for which a cure is not possible

Any location where you call home



Any Life-limiting illness, not just cancer

- Respiratory Diseases (COPD)
- Heart Disease
- Cancer
- Renal Failure (end stage)
- Alzheimer's, Dementia, Parkinson's and Huntington's
- Any life-limiting illness or condition for which a cure is not possible; *Not just end-stage*.

- Interdisciplinary Care team to care for individual and family
- Hospice services
- DME (durable medical equipment)
- Opioid / Medication disposal
- Enhanced Services

- Primary Care Physician
- Hospice Medical Director
- Medical Social Worker
- Spiritual Care Chaplain
- Hospice Home Health Aide
- Trained Volunteers
- Grief Support



Hudson Valley Hospice Services

- We care for the patient and family
- •HV Hospice provides Caregiver Training to family
- Weekly HOME visits from RN
- Pain and symptom management
- Medical Equipment and supplies
- Medications for primary diagnosis
- On-call clinicians available 24/7
- Trained Hospice Volunteers provide
 - Companionship, help & respite for the caregiver
- Support services and spiritual counsel
- Bereavement support for 13 months after patient's death
